"Clarence Jordan, co-founder of Koinonia Farm, wrote, 'The resurrection of Jesus was God's unwillingness to take our "no" for an answer. He raised Jesus, not as an invitation to us to come to Heaven when we die, but as a declaration that he himself has now established permanent, eternal residence here on earth. He is standing beside us, strengthening us in his life. The good news of the resurrection of Jesus is not that we shall die and go home to be with him, but that he has risen and comes home with us, bringing all his hungry, naked, thirsty, sick, prisoner brothers with him." No matter where we have been or what we have gone through, we are to build the community of God in this world to mirror the kingdom in heaven. Easter is the time to celebrate and live as Jesus taught and as God created us to live.


